Minutes of the South Hill Parish Council held in the Parish Hall, at Golberdon on Tuesday 19th December at 7.30.pm.

- 2 Public Session :-** The members of the public were invited to address the Council. The members of the public had come to comment on planning application PA1909484. As a result of their comments the chairman reminded committee members of their responsibilities as Parish Councillors. Members of the public left the meeting at 7.50.pm
- 3 Apologies** was received from Cllr. P. Tunnicliff and Jenny Hoskin (Parish Clerk).
- 4 Cornwall Council:-** Councillor Dawe was not present and no report received.
- 5 Minutes of the last meeting ,** the minutes will be presented at the next meeting.
- 6 Planning application -**
PA23/09644 – National Grid Electricity Distribution (South West) Plc, Great Lanhargy Line, Callington - Install 3rd 11KV wire from 45PSG6 main line along entire HV spur highlighted yellow on attached schematic plan. Distance of 3rd wire installation is approximately 11KM. Pole replacements and stay replacements as required; all of these works will be done on a like for like construction basis with all old poles, stays and fittings removed from work on completion. New fixtures and fittings will be attached to each of the poles, a new line will be pulled through using a winch system and the line will be sagged and tensioned to match the existing conductors and secure in place using performed binds attached to each of the pole top insulators. The parish council supported this application.
- 7 Accounts** The chairman reported that money had been received from HMRC, details next month. It was agreed to pay the £324. for the Western Web update, the clerk's salary and tax.
