Survey Results

101 people looked at the survey, and we have 100 responses of some sort.

96 said they either lived, worked or owned land in the parish, 1 did not, and 3 skipped the question.

73 people gave us their name, 1 put other text here, and 26 skipped this question.

77 people told us where they lived, 1 gave a vague area address, and 22 skipped this question.

2 people live outside the parish. 2 people failed to give a name or address.

In summary, we have meaningful replies from 72 people who we can verify as living in, or very close to the parish. I have included all the replies in the table below, since the replies from those people who failed to give either a name or address followed broadly the same pattern as those who did.

With the energy policy question no-one said they thought existing government policy was adequate, or that they agreed that a community energy policy is a good idea. I think we can ignore this, because the way the question was framed means they preferred to simply support or oppose our policy E1.

The percentage results, shown in bold, are probably the most significant. They show strong support for our 2 business policies, and more divided opinion about the energy policy.
