Minutes of the Meeting of South Hill Parish Council held in the Parish Hall, Golberdon on Tuesday, 20TH January 2026 at 7.30pm.

1	<p>Councillors present – A Budd (Chairman), G Hardman (Vice Chairman), D Hicks, Mrs H Curtis, P Tunnicliffe, J Gale (Parish and Cornwall Council), P Hartley, R Squires.</p> <p>Also attending – Mrs J Hoskin (Parish Clerk) Ten members of the public</p>	
2	<p>Public Session (meeting then closes to the public). The Chairman opened the meeting and invited the members of the public to address the council, if they so wished. Residents of Maders spoke about recent flooding and asked when the Parish Council were going to address the issue of the water run-off from their field down a lane to the main road. Councillors explained they were looking at options and wanted the work to ensure that by renewing a drainage pipe this did not make the water run off faster and create a larger problem. A meeting had been held with Cormac.</p> <p>Councillors appreciated the frustration of residents in the length of time this was taking to resolve.</p> <p>Cllr Gale reiterated the Councils comments and he was in communication with a Cormac officer to find a resolution to their work that needed to be done.</p> <p>There was also the fact that the higher field belonged to another landowner and the bridleway was unadopted.</p> <p>Residents of Bray Shop spoke about planning application PA25/08553 on tonight's agenda and expressed their views on the site in general, and the proposals.</p> <p>Other matters highlighted the drainage at Golberdon that was unable to take the amount of surface water. Problems may be exacerbated by adjacent land currently being arable and not in long term grass that may have taken some of the natural drainage on the land.</p> <p>The request by SHARE to place a shed on the Community Orchard land was explained.</p> <p>The Council were asked by the Working Party to become involved in the Affordable Housing scheme and to apply for funding for a feasibility study.</p> <p>The public session closed at 8.40pm. Two members of the public remained for the remainder of the meeting.</p>

Cllr Hardman declared an interest in the request by SHARE for a shed on the Community Orchard Site (to be discussed under Item 13 of this meeting).</p> <p>Cllr Gale declared an interest in any planning matters (agenda item 8) being the local Cornwall Council ward member and sitting on the CC East Planning Committee.</p>	
5	<p>Cornwall Council – report from Cllr J Gale spoke about the Full Council meeting held earlier today. One of the main motions was the proposed changes in rates for businesses that would have a huge impact on pubs and hospitality venues. The council also supported a motion to government, put forward by Reform, not to accept the removal of trial by jury.</p> <p>A dentistry college was to be established in Cornwall.</p> <p>Cllr Gale spoke about the financial cuts that needed to be made over the next few years.</p> <p>A consultation was currently being held in relation to the administration costs for the Tamar Bridge tags that were recommended to go up from 80p to £2.00 per month. In future tags would no longer be posted but made available for collection from the Bridge office. Heritage funding for the visitor centre was to stop. A request had been made to scrutinize costs of the Tamar Bridge and Torpoint Ferry.</p> <p>The housing crisis was an ongoing problem.</p> <p>Cllr Gale spoke about the planning process, appeals and procedures.</p> <p>The current consultation on the review of parking charges highlighted the introduction of payment machines at many small car parks and venues including Kit Hill. This site was under debate given the land was gifted by the monarchy.</p> <p>The fifth round of CIL funding was now open for applications, along with the Community Network Highway Scheme.</p>	
6	<p>Minutes – to approve the Minutes of the Meeting held on the 18th November 2025. It was agreed paragraph 14 of the Minutes of the Meetings held on the 18th November be amended and they be held over until the next meeting for approval.</p>

8	<p>Planning Applications / Planning Matters to include applications received between the publication of the agenda and the meeting.</p> <p>PA25/07938 Trenance, South Hill – Proposed single storey front porch, garage conversion and detached car port. No objection, proposed by Cllr Hicks, seconded by Cllr Hardman and unanimously agreed.</p> <p>PA25/08553 Land North East of Blacksmiths, Trefinnick Road, Bray Shop – Outline application for the construction of 2 dwellings and associated works (all matters reserved). The parish council had no objection in principle to building on this site, but did have reservations about the plot size and number of properties. There is concern about the safety of the access bearing in mind the scale of the development and likely vehicular movements. The design is not in-keeping with surrounding properties. Proposed by Cllr Hardman, seconded by Cllr Tunnicliffe and unanimously agreed.</p>

The wildflower area at the top of the field had been trimmed. SHARE will invoice the parish council for this work. Cllr Hardman was thanked for carrying out this work. Cllr Hardman declared an interest.</p>																													
12	<p>Footpaths – update on trimming and work required. Cllr Tunnicliffe reported the obstruction to the path at Woodlands had not been removed. Cornwall Council had limited funding and were currently only dealing with emergency work on public rights of way. Cllr Tunnicliffe would investigate the cost of a sign and post.</p>	PT																												
13	<p>Allotments – update and identify any work required. Having considered the options for reinstating the gateway at the allotments, it was proposed by Cllr Curtis seconded by Cllr Squires that Option 1 be accepted. This was unanimously agreed. Cllr Curtis reported plot number 15 had now been cleared and a new tenant had been issued with a tenancy agreement. The outside and top of the boundary hedge to be trimmed. Cllr Hartley offered to assist Cllr Curtis with overseeing the allotments. The council supported the request by SHARE to place a shed on the community orchard site.</p>	AB DH PH/HC
